Tiffin Tomorrow's Progress

Many wonderful things have happened since I began my position as downtown manager for Tiffin Tomorrow. I would like to take this opportunity to review the accomplishments of our group over the past ten months.

Tiffin Tomorrow was established last April as a not-for-profit organization. Its goal is to lead the community in the implementations of the City of Tiffin's redevelopment plan, and to carry out the plan's strategies and initiatives to stop the decline of Tiffin's downtown area and promote its economic development. One of the first steps was to establish the Tiffin Tomorrow office, followed by the organization of the Design and Promotion Committees.

Events of the past ten months have included the second annual Jazzin' Tiffin Festival in conjunction with the Tiffin Art Guild Show, the Historic Tiffin Train Depot soup event, and Greenlawn Cemetery trolley tour, the American Civil War Museum of Ohio fundraiser, assistance with the Holiday Happenings Weekend, and Little Box Shops activities and four downtown clean-up days.

Tiffin Tomorrow has also attended the AAA promotion day at the Ohio State Fair and distributed nearly 900 "Fun Things to Do in Tiffin, Ohio" packets. We have conducted a focus group with Tiffin University business students, and organized service work at the Spiva Manley restoration project for Heidelberg University students. Projects currently under way include the downtown lamp post refurbishing project, and a plan to use CDBG funds to purchase and complete exterior restoration work on the property at 22 S. Washington Street.

We are currently planning the third annual Jazzin' Tiffin festival, a hanging basket plant sale, and downtown clean-ups for this coming year.

2011 will be an exciting year for downtown Tiffin.
